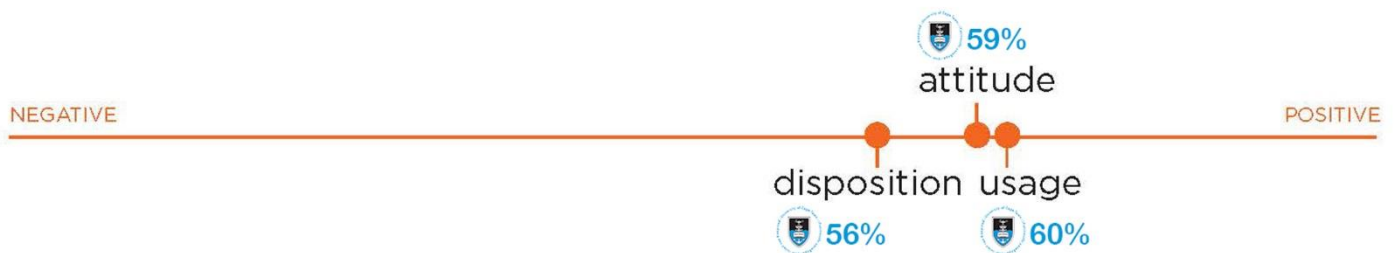

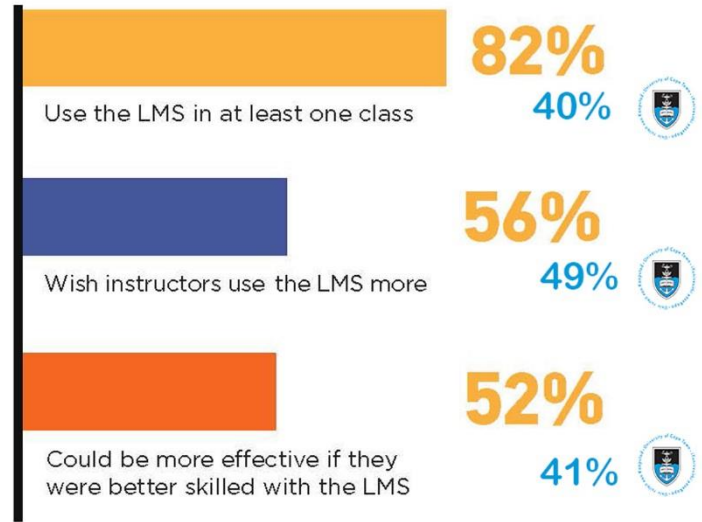
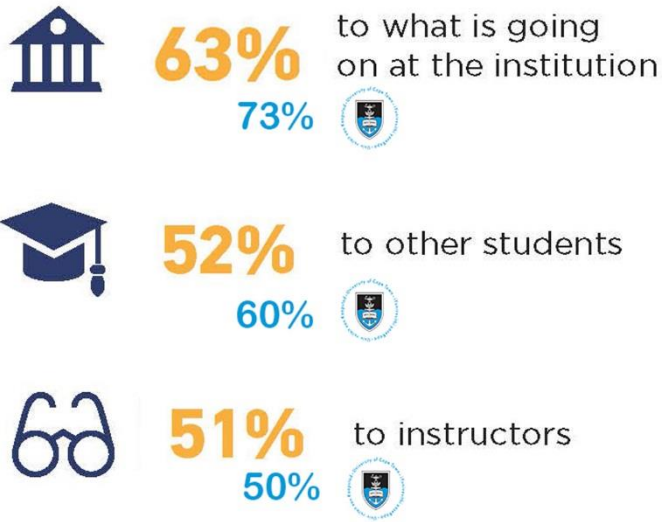

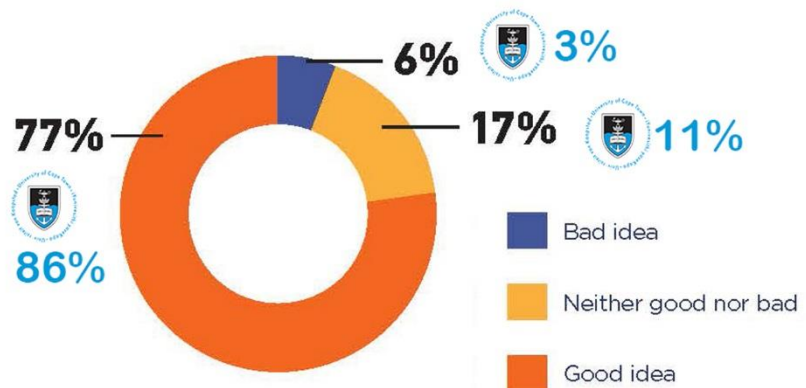
Students say that technology makes them feel connected...

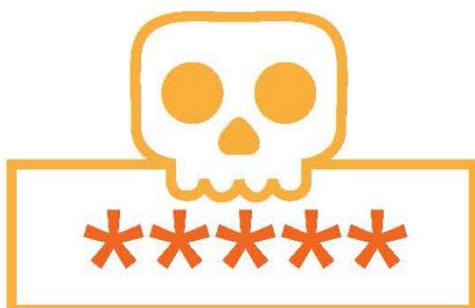


# ANALYTICS AND DATA PRIVACY

## SHARING YOUR PIN OR PASSWORD: AS RISKY AS IT SOUNDS!



Students who have **shared the password or PIN for an online account** in the past 12 months are twice as likely to have had an account hacked than students who haven't. **(36% vs. 18%)**

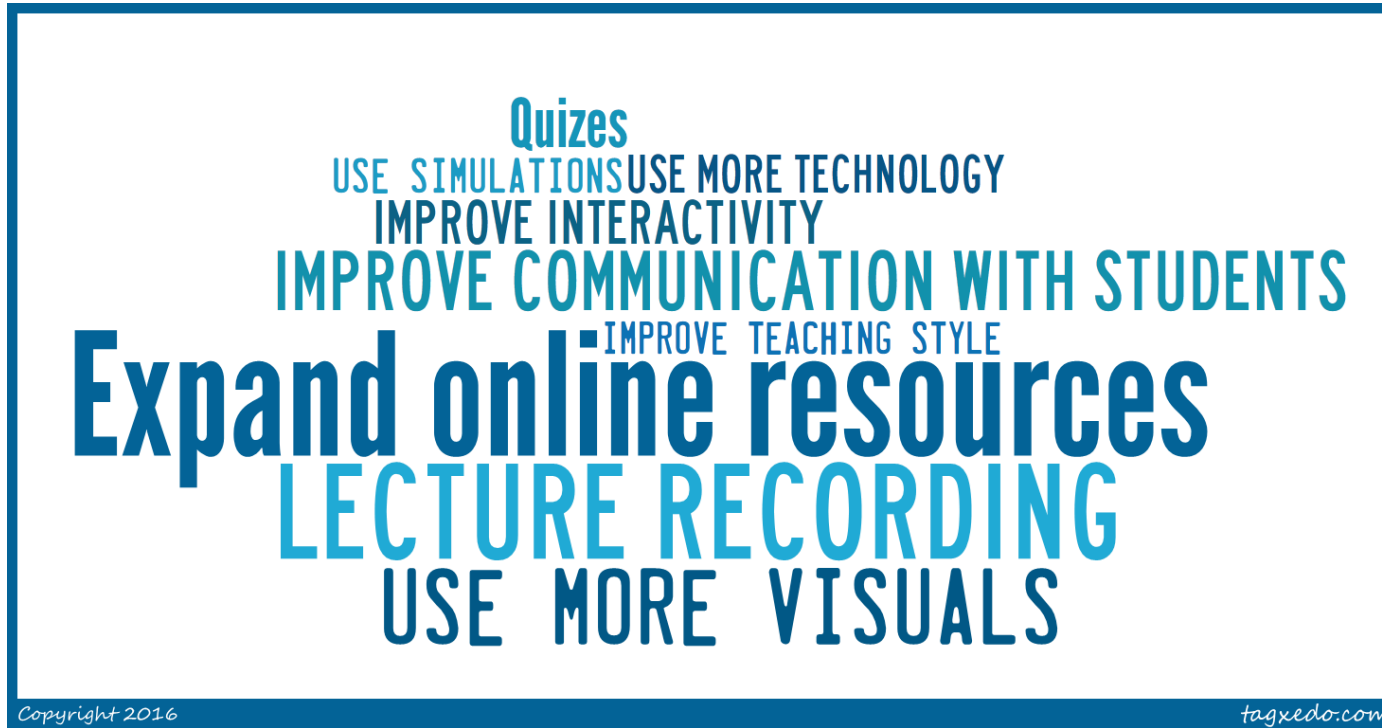

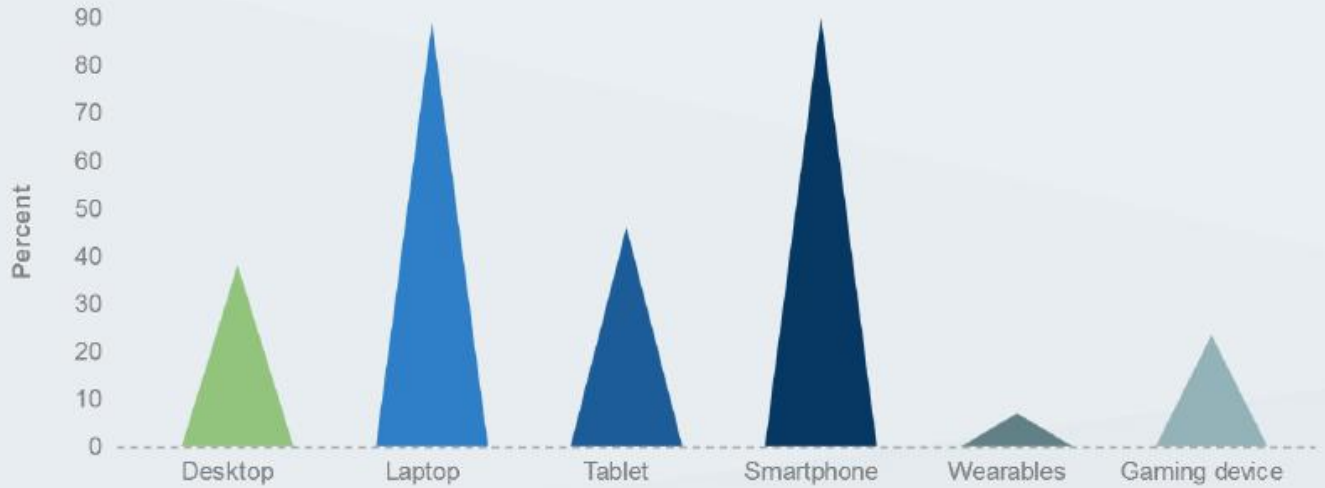

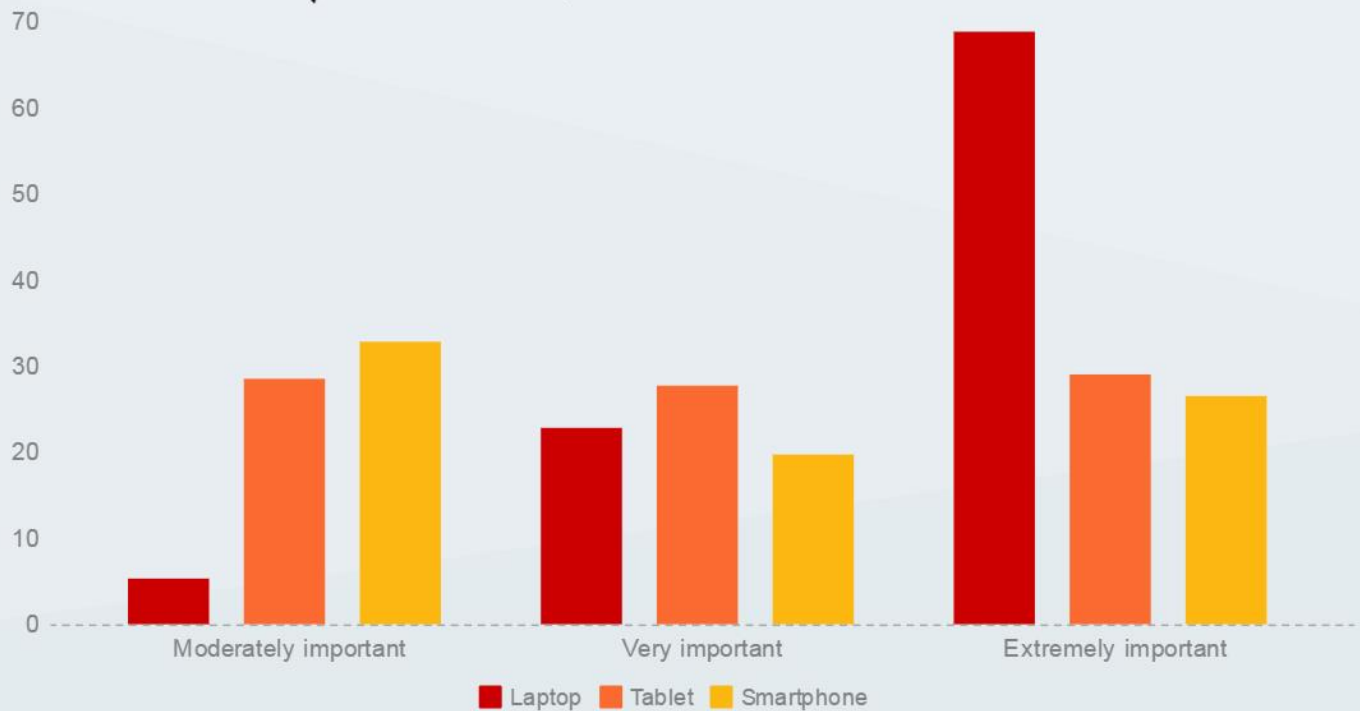

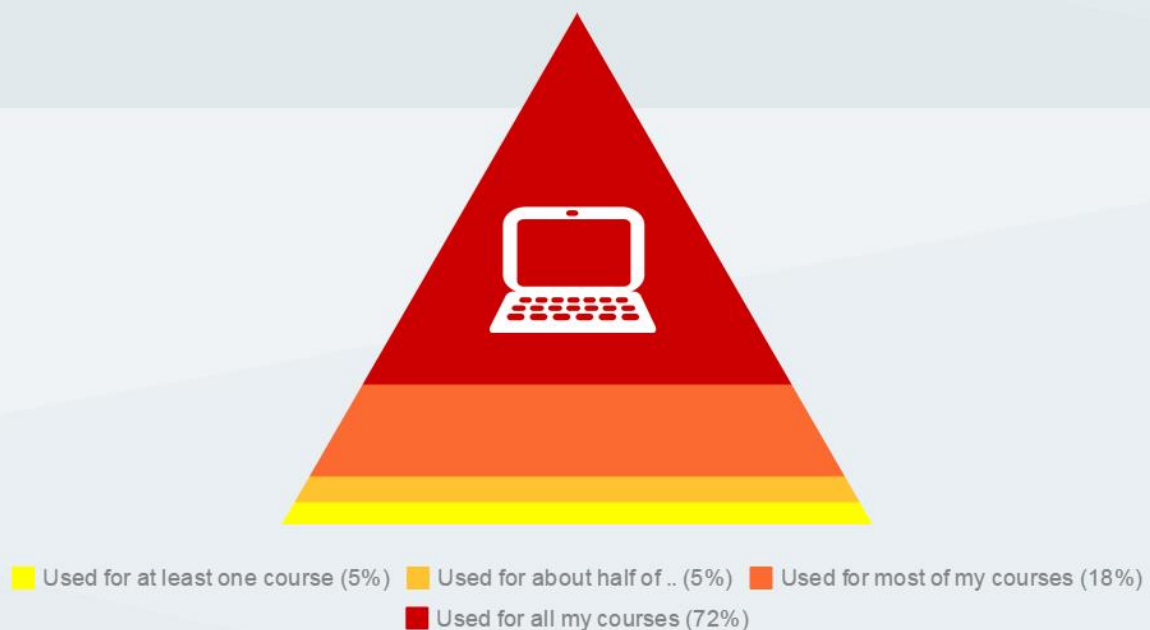

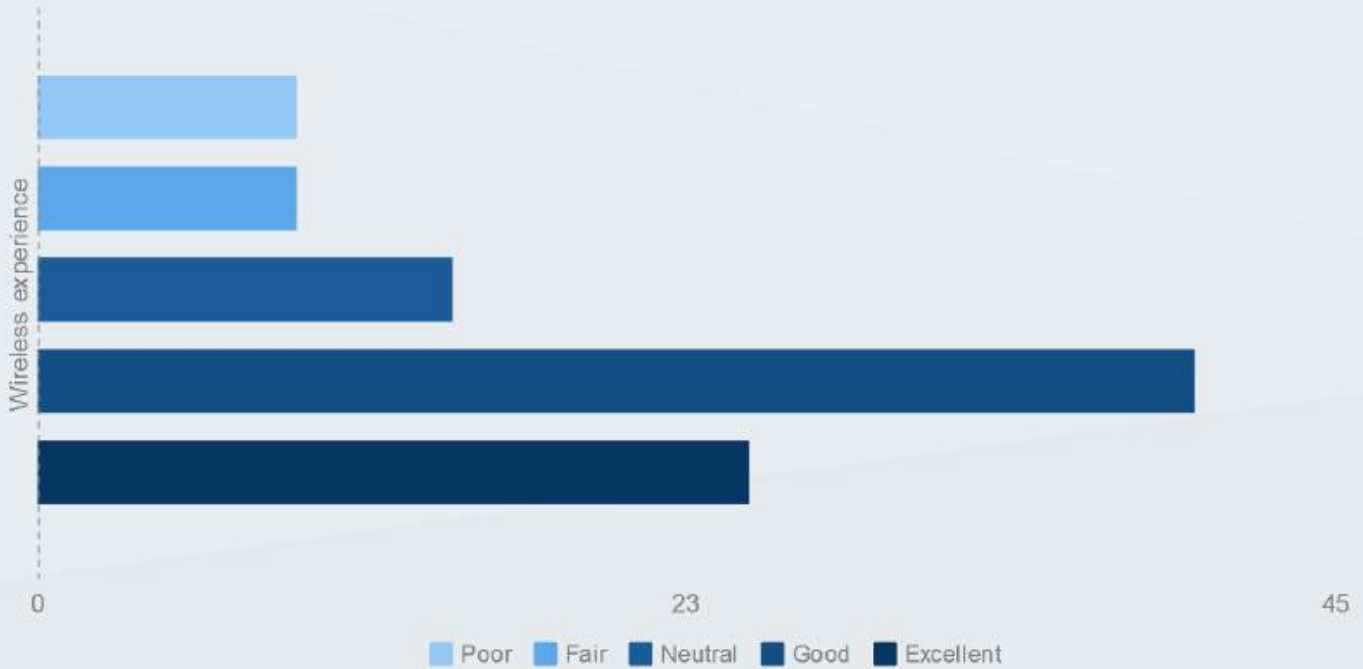

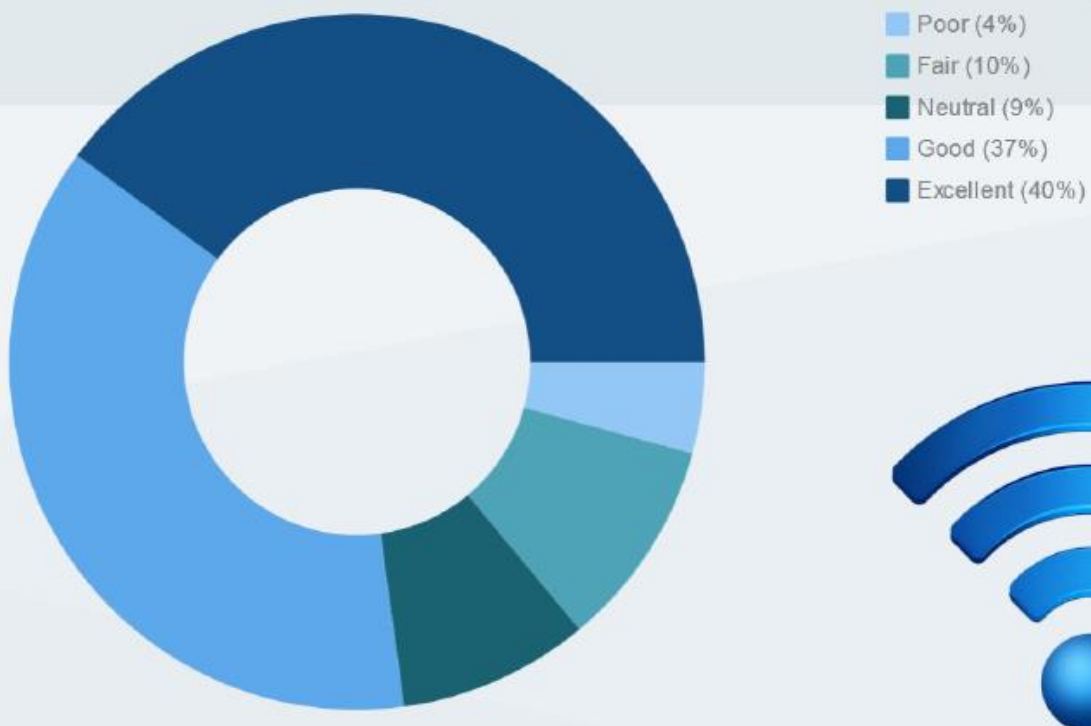
