How risky are your online activities?*




• 80% of people who view adult content and gamble online have been victims



• Of the 66% of people who connect to free unsecured wifi, 77% have been victims



• 78% of people who lie about their identies or create fake profiles have been victims

Other high-risk activities include:


- Not using reputable anti-virus software

STAYING SAFE

Use a reputable anti-virus program





Defend your data: encrypt and back it up

Get a tracking app if one is available for your device





Always scan external devices

Never share your password. Use unique passwords for all accounts





Beware of risky behaviour online
