Possible security warnings when installing Papercut

1. Anti-virus warning

If you are running anti-virus or security software additional to the McAfee software provided at UCT, you might receive a warning message indicating Papercut is not secure when running the .exe file.

1. If a pop-up appears such as the one indicated above, you will need to disable your anti-virus software while you complete the installation.

2. Windows Defender warning

If you have **Windows Defender** or other Windows security software running, you might receive an error indicating the software contains a virus or potentially unwanted software.

1. Go to the Windows Settings panel by clicking on Start Button and then the gear icon.



2. Select Update and Security and then select Windows Defender.

3. Disable **Real-time protection** and continue with the installation.
