SHARING YOUR PIN OR PASSWORD: AS RISKY AS IT SOUNDS!

Students who have **shared the password or PIN for an online account** in the past 12 months are twice as likely to have had an account hacked than students who haven't. (36% vs. 18%)

Four in five students say they have taken a course with a blend of some online and some face-to-face work.
