Students Checklist

Before you arrive on campus

- Manage your account by changing your temporary password.
- Set up your **Multi-factor authentication (MFA)**.
- Access your **myUCT email** and get access to free online storage with OneDrive.
- Download and install **Office 365** for free.
- Download **UCT Mobile**, the university's all-in-one-mobile app for your phone.
- Like and follow our social media pages: **Facebook, X, YouTube and LinkedIn**.
- Sign up to our **icts-announce-l mailing list**.

When you get to campus

- Go to the **ICTS website** for all the information you need.
- Find **computer labs** on campus.
- Connect your devices to the internet via **eduroam WiFi**.
- Get set up to copy, print and scan with **UCT Managed Print Solutions**.
- Sign into **Vula** or **Amathuba**, your online learning portal.
- Browse and install any **free or site-licenced software** you might need for your studies from our downloads site.
- Access **LinkedIn Learning** for thousands of tutorials from subject matter experts.
- Access **Google Workspace** offering you Google apps and cloud storage.

When you get to residence (applies to res students)

- Connect your device(s) to the internet.
- Find out who your **House Comm IT representative** is.

Protect yourself online

- Install **Trellix antivirus** software on your computer.
- Set up your computer to receive **Windows, Mac or Linux** updates.
- Always be on the lookout for suspicious emails and links and report any cybersecurity incidents to the **CSIRT (UCT's Computer Security Incident Response Team)**.
- Read our **cybersecurity resources** to ensure you stay safe online.
